YCT Endorse Scott Sanford for House District 70

Austin, TX — Young Conservatives of Texas (YCT) announced today their endorsement of Scott Sanford of McKinney for Texas House District 70 (HD 70). The seat is currently held by Rep. Ken Paxton, who is currently running for Texas Senate.

"The conservative voters of House District 70 gave us Ken Paxton, who sits atop YCT's historic honor roll," said Tony McDonald, YCT Senior Vice Chairman. "As Representative Paxton moves to the Senate, we know they will elect another true conservative leader, Scott Sanford, to replace him in the Texas House.
