Young Conservatives of Texas has selected the following bills which it believes accurately serve to gauge a legislator's philosophy in light of YCT's principles.

These bills are the basis of our Legislative Voting Index.

In the Index, "+" indicates that the legislator voted FOR the conservative position as determined by YCT. "-" indicates that the legislator voted AGAINST the conservative position.

A "P" indicates that the legislator was present but did not vote, and "E" indicates an excused absence. A blank indicates a non-excused absence. No penalty is accessed for excused absences, however, non-excused absences are counted as a half negative vote.

The higher the score, the better the legislator promotes the conservative position of limited government and individual freedom.

- 1. Motion to table Amendment to CSSB 341. The original bill provided that upon an appeal by a teacher of a school board decision to fire, if the court finds that the Board acted in bad faith, the court may award attorney's fees and punitive damages to the teacher. This amendment would even up the procedure by allowing the court to award attorney's fees and court costs to the school board if the court upholds its decision to terminate. YCT No.
- 2. CSSB 121 Second Reading. Texas has been the only state that has not admitted oral confessions into evidence. This bill, part of the Governor's crime package, makes such confessions admissible. YCT Yes. Aids in the prosecution of the criminal element.
- 3. SB 2 Second Reading. This bill would prohibit abuse of unemployment compensation by denying compensation payments to those who voluntarily quit their jobs or are fired for theft or misconduct. Those denied compen-

- sation could be eligible for benefits if they return to work at old or new job for 15 weeks. YCT - Yes.
- 4. HB 1269 This bill provides a procedure for setting up pilot teacher evaluation programs. YCT Yes. Good education measure.
- 5. SB 264 This bill would prohibit the "agency shop", which is back door compulsory union agreement whereby an employee in a unionized company must pay union dues or their equivalent if he chooses not to join the union. YCT-Yes. Texans "Right to Work" must be protected. Compulsory unionism must be stopped.
- 6. HB 360 To permit law enforcement officials to obtain court orders, upon proof of probable cause, for wiretapping against smugglers and pushers of hard drugs. YCT Yes. Good crime prevention measure.
- 7. CSSB 706 Second Reading. This bill allows judges to be elected on a non par-

tisan ballot. YCT - Yes. Justice should not be administered on a Republican or Democratic basis.

- 8. Motion to table Jones Amendment to CSSB 477 This amendment to the Bilingual Education Bill provides that a student who has had four years of bilingual ed may be transferred out into a transitional program. YCT No. This bill is in keeping with the basic legitimate reason foe bilingual education, to teach the student English, rather that re-enforce the students. Spanish knowledge.
- 9. Motion to table Leedom Amendment to CSSB 477 This amendment provides that the student's parents must approve his entry or continuance in a bilingual education program. YCT No.
- 10. CSSB 1228 Second Reading. This bill removes the statutory interest rate on personal loans, allowing them to float up to the free market level. YCT-Yes. The only way to see that loans are made is to let the interest rate equal the cost of money. Keep the government out of the banking business.
- 11. Amendment to CSSB 1228 This amendment in affect would "gut" the intent and purpose of CSSB 1228 as it was passed on the Second Reading. YCT No.
- 12. SB 118 Second Reading. Would overturn the ruling by the Texas Attorney General that union dues could be "checked-off" by state employees from their paycheck. YCT Yes. A "check-off" facilitates union organizing, thus furthering efforts to unionize state employees.

Pates the 67th Texas Legislature

House Votes - House Bill Descriptions

- HB 360 Would allow law enforcement officials to install & monitor electric eavesdropping appliances for the control of illegal drug trafficing. YCT Yes. Effective anti-crime measure.
- HB 1228 Raised the maximum ceiling of allowable interest rates charged by lending institutions to 24%. YCT - Yes. Allow the free market to work more effectively.
- 3. Motion to postpone, Motion to table HB 30, which would have allowed banks and other financial intermediaries to bid competitively for state funds also allowed state to diversify liquid assets thus increasing the return of taxpayer's money. Would have also allowed local government entities to participate in a statewide pool of funds to be diversified, thus receiving a higher return than they (local govts.) could have received on their own. YCT Yes. Texas citizens should receive the highest allowable returns on their taxes.
- 4. HB 1972 This bill would have required state & local governments to set aside 10% of construction funds for minority contractors. YCT No. Contracts should be awarded to the lowest bidder, not to anyone special interest.
- 5. HB 551 This bill would have prohibited local school boards from recognizing one single organization for consultation of teachers. It did not prohibit individual consultation, though. YCT Yes. One organization should not have a monopoly on the representation of a working class there are too many factions within this group of workers.
- 6. SB 173 This bill exempted certain child care facilities from licensing if they met standards. YCT Yes. Eliminates unnecessary regulation.
- 7. Motion to table Glossbrenner Amendment to HB 578, this amendment to Bill Ceverha's Bill (parental consent required for abortion) would have allowed a child to receive an abortion without her parent's consent if another doctor, other than the one performing the abortion, felt the patient was "mature" enough to make her own decision. YCT No. In a decision so

- important as this, a child may not have the maturity to determine whether or not to have an abortion.
- 8. Motion to table HB 1111, this bill would revoke the Governor's approval power required for parole. This change, according to the author, would result in thousands of convicts being paroled who the Gov. heretofore determined not deserving of parole. YCT Yes. Such a bill would not only potentially endanger the lives of all Texans, but would weaken the powers of the already weak executive branch.
- SB 118 Disallows union dues from being automatically deducted from state worker's pay. YCT - No. The state should not be in the business of performing activities for organized labor.
- 10. SB 606 Would have required the licensing and regulation of all persons who consider their occupation to be a "counselor". Would have affected counselors at high schools, colleges, summer camps, etc. YCT No. Unnecessary regulation of the private sector.

- 11. HB 2278 This bill allowed the creation of the 1st phase of a multimillion dollar human services center, the first phase alone costing \$67 million. Directed the hiring of 26 new employees for maintainance/security. YCT No. Such a project is much too expensive and elaborate (not to mention what its purpose is) for taxpayers.
- 12. HB 656 Green-Luna Amendment Would have decreased funding for the arts by approx. \$1 million for the biennium. YCT Yes. Funding for the arts is not a proper function of government.
- 13. Motion to table Danburg Amendment to HB 656, this would have added \$7 million to the Welfare budget for family planning. YCT Yes. Family planning is not a legitimate function of government.
- 14. HJR 62 Passage to 3rd Reading In this form, eliminated the cap for annual Welfare payments not just raised it. YCT No. A limitless payment of aid to families is irresponsible.

15. Motion to table Fox Amendment to SB 477 This amendment would have required those students in the bilingual program to be placed in another program, if after 4 years they are not progressing satisfactorily. YCT - No. This amendment would allow the program to run more smoothly, and put slow students in remedial programs instead of having them slow down the whole program.

16. HB 467 Provided for the education of offspring of persons illegally residing in the State of Texas. YCT - No. Texans should only provide education to those people legally residing here.

17. HB 698, as amended, passage to third Reading. This bill includes farm and ranch laborers under the coverage of the Workers Compensation Act. The only exemptions under this bill are those farm and ranch laborers who are employed by a family farm or employed by a family with 10 or fewer employees. YCT - No. Requires farmers to pay into Workers Compensation.

18. SB 2 Disallows unemployment compensation to those workers who voluntarily leave their jobs. YCT - Yes. People should not be subsidized by businesses when they could still be working for a living.

YOUNG CONSERVATIVES OF TEXAS
